



CHIARI MALFORMATION CONDITION

The person holding this medical alert card has a Chiari Malformation condition.

A condition in which brain tissue extends into the spinal canal. This puts pressure on parts of the brain and spinal cord, and can cause mild to severe symptoms.

This can cause dizziness, problems with coordination and fine motor skills, pain, difficulties swallowing or speaking, hearing or balance problems, muscle weakness or numbness, breathing, and excessive drooling, gagging or vomiting.

This person may urgently require a place to sit or lay down that is away from loud sounds and bright lights. Your kindness and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.
